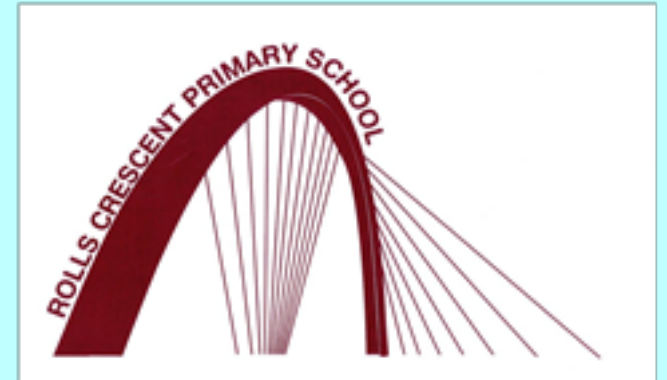

School Routines

MORNINGSSchool gates open at 8:30 a.m. and are locked 9am.

Children enter school at 9:00am.

Late arrivals should enter the building via the main office at the front of the school.

Assessment

Continuous

Ongoing assessments will be made of your child through informal observations, marking, weekly checks, dialogue with children and colleagues etc.



Formal

Formal assessments will occur three times a year in October, December and February for grammar, reading and maths. Writing will be assessed continuously.
