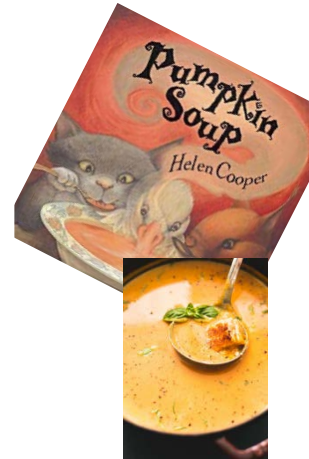


Nursery Newsletter

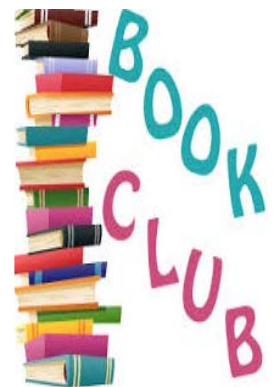
